Chlorine Sensitivity

As you know our water treatment facility is now up and running. Our treatment plant uses chlorine to kill any harmful pathogens in the water we use on a daily basis. The amount of chlorine used in our water does not make the water harmful to drink. It does however leave a taste perhaps that is not appealing or perhaps does not feel good on our skin. Here are some helpful solutions to help reduce the effects of chlorine;

- Leaving water out for 20 to 30 minutes will allow for the chlorine to dissipate prior to consumption.
- Vitamin C crystals added water immediately breaks down the chlorine for a quicker effect.
- Instead of showering, run a bath and let sit for 30 minutes prior to immersing yourself in the water.

Home Carbon Filter

If you feel that these solutions do not help with your sensitivity to the chlorine a carbon filter is another option that you can choose.

Home Carbon Filters are installed prior to any water reaching the home therefore all water entering the home is treated and chlorine removed.

Average costs for this is between \$1700-\$2000
