Recycling and Waste Management Program

Dear Coyote Rock Estates Residence:

Williams Lake First Nation is introducing a new recycling and waste management program effective immediately. Your new recycling and garbage bins were delivered on March 4, 2021 and pick up will begin March 5, 2021 between 8:30 – 4:30, recurring weekly on Fridays except for statutory holidays. Please have your bins located curbside for pickup before 8:30 AM.

What Goes in Each Container?

Recyclables – All clean paper, glass bottles and jars, aluminum foil and cans, steel/tin cans, and plastic containers belong in the blue containers.

Garbage – Very few items belong in the garbage. Items that should be put in the garbage include foam cups and packaging, candy wrappers, chip bags, and aseptic packaging (juice boxes/Tetrapaks). Any material put in the garbage is sent to landfill.

Payment Options:

Service and administration fees for this program are \$425.00 annually and can be made in two bi-annual installments. You will receive an invoice for the full amount in April of each year. If you choose to pay bi-annually you will receive a reminder in September to pay the remaining amount. Payment can be made in one of three ways:

- In person at the Band office in Sugar Cane 2672 Indian Drive, Sugar Cane Reserve
- In person at the WLFN Natural Resources Building at 315 Yorston Street, Williams Lake
- E-transfer to onlinepay@wlfn.ca
