## **ST. JOSEPH'S MISSION INVESTIGATION GEOPHYSICAL RESULTS**

Chief and Council of the Williams Lake First Nation (WLFN) will be releasing the preliminary geophysical results from the second phase of the St. Joseph's Mission Residential School investigation on **Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.

"As we conclude the second phase of the geophysical investigation at the St. Joseph's Mission, it has given WLFN greater clarity for what needs to happen next as we progress in our investigation. As many communities across the country start or continue their investigations into Indian Residential Schools, we must work together to support each other, uplift each other, and ultimately move forward in a positive direction for our people and our communities. We will continue to pursue the truth and we will continue to seek justice for those children and their families" states Chief Willie Sellars.

Prior to releasing the geophysical investigation results to the public, WLFN will be conducting a meeting with the Chiefs of the communities directly affected by the operations at the St. Joseph's Mission. This meeting will take place on the morning of January 25<sup>th</sup> and will provide Leadership with an opportunity to ask questions of the technical experts involved in the second phase of the investigation. This session is closed to the media and to the public, and attendance is by invitation only.

In the afternoon of January 25<sup>th</sup>, an announcement will be held releasing the preliminary results of the geophysical investigation. The anticipated start time for this session is 1:00 PM on January 25<sup>th</sup>, at 2561 Quilgi Drive.
